The Castle Vöhlín Seminar Centre is the seminar, management and conference centre of the three Universities of Applied Sciences in Augsburg, Kempten and Neu-Ulm. This is where students and professors, as well as entrepreneurs, meet to plan and realise joint projects. The location and its historical ambience offer ideal opportunities and spaces for the development of innovative educational concepts and new ideas.

For representatives from the fields of politics, academia and business, the Seminar Centre, with its easy-to-reach location and rooms with modern equipment, is well-suited for meetings, conferences and training courses away from the demands of everyday working life.

## Room for ideas

Five workshop and seminar rooms for up to 18 participants each and two conference rooms for up to 80 people are available in a complex of approximately 1,000 square metres. There is also a start-up room which students of the Universities of Applied Sciences in Augsburg, Kempten and Neu-Ulm can use for their entrepreneurial projects free of charge.

The bright rooms with high ceilings at the Castle Vöhlín Seminar Centre are equipped with the newest media and presentation technology, including full HD projectors, notebooks, HD video cameras, visualizers and interactive whiteboards.

The Renaissance-era wooden and stucco ceilings present a contrast to the modern furnishings. The hilltop location provides an excellent view of Illertissen and the Iller valley as far away as the Ulm Minster and the Alps.

## Medieval meets Modern



Vöhlín Castle in Illertissen with its gardens is one of the most remarkable sites in Bavarian Swabia.

The castle, originally known as Castle Tissen, was built in the 12th and 13th centuries by the Counts of Aicham. In 1520 it was purchased by the merchant and patrician family Vöhlín from Memmingen and remained the private property of the family for over 230 years.

After 1803 the castle was significant in the region as the seat of many state and town offices and agencies. In mid-2009 the branch of the Neu-Ulm Local Court, the castle's most recent occupant, was dissolved.

The Universities of Applied Sciences of Augsburg, Kempten and Neu-Ulm have used the main building and side wing as a modern seminar, management and conference centre since 2010.
